**Outline syllabus:** The student undertakes the role of stage / technical operator during performance or recording. Involved in the preparation of the production, the student will operate the lighting board, sound desk or other stage or technical equipment for the run of the production. This module applies equally to the operation of technical equipment during recordings.
