## Part 2: Description

Drawing on clinical expertise and research the module will enable healthcare professionals to develop their knowledge, understanding and professional practice within the speciality of oncology and beyond.

## Part 3: Assessment

Students will develop and submit a conference style poster which critically explores an aspect of cancer care related to their practice or learning. Students will defend their poster in a viva consisting of a 10 minute presentation and 10 minutes question and answer session (A). The poster and viva will be assessed. Students will have opportunity for formative support and assessment throughout the module via assignment support sessions and feedback on a poster and presentation plans.
