Students will be expected to undertake guided tasks each week, which may include case study analysis, relevant readings, media or field research, to maximise the benefits and impact of the in-class sessions.

### Part 3: Assessment

The written assignment will be focused around applying essential operations and supply concepts in a practical setting .

Guidance and formative feedback opportunities for the written assignment will be offered in the tutorial sessions. Marking criteria will be specified in the assignment brief and will be reviewed annually to ensure they continue to reflect the learning outcomes and overall assessment strategy.
