Part 2: Description

The confidence and ability to think critically, apply knowledge and skills, and provide expert, evidencebased, nursing care lies at the centre of nursing practice. This module offers final year nursing students to consider long term career pathways prior to registration. Reflecting that enquiry and exploration are at the heart of the Future Nurse curriculum, this module has a particular focus on evidence and principles that underpin high dependency care of children and young people and the role of the nurse in influencing and contributing to the processes of organisational change in improving care delivery for individuals through an awareness of national and international policies

This module will use a range of learning and teaching strategies to support student learning and will include:

- Lectures
- Scenario based teaching through interaction and simulation
- Group work
- Self-directed learning
- Digital learning delivered through Blackboard and other virtual learning platforms

Part 3: Assessment: Strategy and Details

The assessment strategy for this module is designed to allow a diverse range of students to be able to explore their own current and future practice focusing on an existing and or emerging model of care.

Formative assessment: Formative assessment: Students will have opportunities to practice mock scenarios through simulation within the module and will be given feedback to build toward the final assessment

Summative assessment: The assignment is by way of a Structured Oral and Practical Examination (SOPE), which comprises of two short practical examinations followed by standardised critical questioning. The critical questions will assess the students understanding of care delivery and will also ascertain their understanding of:

- Processes of transfer and stabilisation of the child or young person
- Ethical and legal considerations of care
- Appropriate literature to support practical examinations and critical questioning.
