## Part 2: Description

The confidence and ability to think critically, apply knowledge and skills, and provide expert, evidence-based, nursing care lies at the centre of nursing practice. This module offers final year nursing students to consider long term career pathways prior to registration. Reflecting that enquiry and exploration are at the heart of the Future Nurse curriculum, this module has a particular focus on the evidence and principles that underpins peri-operative care and the role of the nurse in influencing and contributing to the processes of organisational change in improving care delivery for individuals through an awareness of national and international policies

This module will use a range of learning and teaching strategies to support student learning and will include:

- Lectures
- Scenario based teaching through interaction and simulation
- Group work
- Self-directed learning
- Digital learning delivered through Blackboard and other virtual learning platforms.

## Part 3: Assessment: Strategy and Details

The assessment strategy for this module is designed to allow a diverse range of students to be able to explore their own current and future practice focusing on an existing and or emerging model of care.

**Formative assessment**: Students will be given the opportunity to present and discuss assignment plans at a seminar within the module

**Summative assessment**: The assignment is by way of a 2000 word document looking holistically at a patient's peri-operative journey broken down into three sections.

Section 1 should introduce the patient and diagnosis and why the decision has been made for surgery. Critical discussions should also include patients experiences of the peri-operative journey including psychological aspects supported with appropriate literature.

Section 2 focus on a specific aspect of the patient's peri-operative journey. Examples that can be used are ethical and legal issues, communication, infection control, decision making and leadership and management supported with appropriate literature and policies.

Section 3 will provide a critical analysis and evaluation of the patient's journey identifying the role of the nurse in enabling a quality experience for the patient from a leadership and management perspective supported with appropriate literature.
