#### Part 2: Description

Leadership and teaching are core skills for the Future Nurse in order to be able to provide safe and effective care. This module will enable nursing students to develop confidence and competence when leading self, peers, students and teams and demonstrate a critical rationale to the mechanisms that affect team dynamics including human factors and learning from mistakes. In accordance with Part 2 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) Standards (2018), it will prepare students to become safe and effective clinical supervisors. Additionally, the module will also further develop students understanding of effective communication required within leadership, teaching and supervision and management that has patients at the centre.

This module will use a range of learning and teaching strategies to support student learning and will include:

- Lectures
- Scenario based teaching through interaction
- Group work
- Self-directed learning
- Digital learning delivered through Blackboard and other virtual learning platforms

The teaching and content will be delivered by academic and practitioners from across the four fields of nursing.

The indicative content of the module will focus on the NMC Future Nursing Standards (2018), focusing on the NMC Standards of proficiency platforms and annex.

- Promoting health and preventing ill health
- Assessing needs and planning care
- Providing and evaluating care
- Leading and managing nursing care and working in teams
- Improving safety and quality of care
- Coordinating care

#### Part 3: Assessment: Strategy and Details

Assessment is by way of a vlog to enable students to be more dynamic in sharing ideas and thoughts with a visual platform further developing students to become confident in teaching and leadership and presenting information in a way that is tangible and improve collaboration skills. It will allow students to learn information at a time and place that is convenient to them in preparing the vlog.

**Formative assessment**: Students are required to present a plan of the proposed vlog and will be given feedback by the module team.

**Summative assessment**: Students are required-to research, prepare and record a 20 minute vlog around the relevance or leadership, management and teaching as a supervisor. The vlog should address the following:

- Supervising students and supporting learning
- Providing timely feedback
- A discussion around communication skills
- Working in a multi-disciplinary team and the impact on delivering person-centred care
- Link the above to effective leadership and management, making reference to organisational culture
