### Part 2: Description

This module engages with the *enterprise* pathway within the core Level 2 module. It is a practice-based introduction to histories on film (documentary, fiction, cinema and television). In addition to critical engagement with the theory informing the presentation of historical material on film, students will receive technical training in production. This module is an alternative core module to UPHNFL-15-2 for students who wish to do a film of their research project rather than a web-based project.

This module serves as preparation for the dissertation module at Level 3, and builds on research, professional and enterprise skills developed at Level 1.

#### Part 3: Assessment

The assessment for this module will be the production of a short film based on researched historical content, on a topic that the student has begun researching in the core level 2 module in semester 1, History in Practice. This will be accompanied by an individual written evaluation (1500 words) that contextualises and situates their film within the theoretical and cultural landscape and reflects on the practical skills developed over the course of the module.

Feedback for assessments will be sent first to students electronically. All students will be invited to attend
