Part 2: Description

This module is primarily focused on preparing you for entry into the Screen Acting industry. You will receive professional and tutor advice on Head shots, CVs, Auditions and castings. You will be given introductions to agents and casting directors. You will participate in workshops including but not limited to: audition technique, self taping, Automated Dialogue Replacement (ADR) and motion-capture. There will be Q& A sessions and various workshops with Industry practitioners. There will be a cinema screening of your final scenes to an invited audience, in London and Bristol.

Part 3: Assessment

Each student will be required to write a 2,000 word self-evaluative essay. Tutors will assess your ability to articulate in writing a systematic understanding and critical evaluation of your own research and current practice.

Other modes of assessment include, continuous class peer and tutor analysis, practice-based research, creating a professional CV, database, showreel and journal.
