**Educational aims:** The main aim of the module is to provide students with basic knowledge of the Latvian language, to introduce grammar structures and vocabulary used in daily conversations as well as in social and state institutions

**Outline syllabus:** Formal and informal greetings. Alphabet. Personal information, describing personality. Verbs, nouns;

Family members, relatives. Saying the dates, e.g. date of birth;

Address. Place of residence. My house, flat. City plan. Transport. Prepositions;

Clothes. Shopping, money. Verbs simple forms formation;

In a café and restaurant. Asking questions and answering them in simple sentences;

## Part 3: Teaching and learning methods

**Teaching and learning methods:** Learning and teaching will be provided to students as practical classes. During practical classes students are working face-to-face with teaching staff discussing topics and by this extending Latvian words amount in their personal vocabulary.

**MO2** Use simple verbs in simple tenses to cover main topics, use simple wordcombinations and numerals for forming language constructions related to the topic.

The topic of the presentation is the student him/herself.
