Part 2: Description

Overview: The module will be undertaken by students intending to pursue a career in law and in particular, to qualify as a Solicitor and be Admitted to the Roll to practice in England & Wales (regulated by the Solicitors Regulation Authority).

This module is intended to prepare students for the specific requirements of the assessment of Functioning Legal Knowledge in Solicitors Qualifying Exam 1 ("SQE

1"). It will equip students to critically analyse case scenarios and apply knowledge of core legal principles and procedure.

Outline syllabus:

SQE1 is a centrally set assessment (administered externally on behalf of the Solicitors Regulation Authority) which a student must pass as part of the qualification framework leading to admission to the Roll to practice as a solicitor

SQE 1 will comprise 2 computer based MCQ assessments of Functioning Legal Knowledge

The SQE1 assessments will assess a candidate's ability to apply fundamental legal principles and rules, appropriately and effectively, at the level required of a competent newly qualified solicitor in practice, to realistic client based and ethical problems and situations.

This module specifically prepares students for the first SQE1 assessment in the following subjects:

Business organisations, rules and procedures Contract Law Tort Law Dispute Resolution Legal System and Public Law Legal Services

Extracts of the SRA SQE Assessment Specification will be included in the STC Handbook.

Part 3: Teaching and learning methods

Teaching and learning methods: The module is delivered through a range of Teaching and Learning methodology which will include:

Self-directed learning

Online learning using a range of platforms including Blackboard

Tutor led small group sessions to embed and reinforce learning of the key concepts

A range of formative assessment exercises to develop student skills in answering single best answer MCQ assessments
