Part 2: Description

Overview: This module will explore how communication, in all its forms, can support educators as facilitators of learning whilst further developing academic skills.

Educational aims: The learning in this module is intended to prepare students for future educational study at a higher level, whilst becoming competent and confident users of English. This will support their current and future studies and employment.

Outline syllabus: This module explores the use of communication skills, to deepen students' understanding of how these can facilitate academic learning. Students will consider their own experiences and reflect on how to engage with key concepts in oral and written communication in order to develop skills in reflective thinking, writing and practice. The module complements and supports others across the programme.

Part 3: Teaching and learning methods

Teaching and learning methods: Scheduled learning: This will include whole cohort lectures, seminars, module tutorials, directed tasks, technology-enhanced learning through online engagement and e-mail contact.

Independent learning – There is an expectation that students engage in at least 2 hours of independent study for every hour of taught provision. This will include reading, directed tasks, working on personal skills and knowledge, preparation for and completion of assignments.
