Outline syllabus: This module provides students with the opportunity to complete a

significant project working in an international team with students from other

universities across the world. Students will develop their cross-cultural

understanding, make international network connections and develop valuable skills

for future employment in the global marketplace. In the second semester, students

will attend a range of international guest speaker masterclasses, addressing current

issues and challenges global business practice and development.

Teaching and learning methods: Experiential learning occurs within collaborative

group settings in the first 6 weeks of the semester as part of a Global Virtual Team of

students based in universities around the world. In addition, learning is developed

through attendance at regular business masterclass lectures and workshops in the

second half of the semester.
