Teaching and learning methods: The Early Childhood programme views teaching

and learning as an active and collaborative process and highly values the student

voice as central to this. Teaching sessions will include a range of activities such as

lectures, group discussions, small group projects, reading analysis and design and

production. Students who attend regularly and engage in the required reading and

activities, both in the sessions and independently, will develop a deeper

understanding of the module topics and debates.

Module Learning outcomes: On successful completion of this module students will

achieve the following learning outcomes.

MO1 Discuss how policy for early childhood education and care arises from

socio-political debates locally, nationally, and internationally.

MO2 Analyse the relationship between policy and practice in early childhood

provision.

MO3 Compare and contrast contemporary early childhood curricula.

MO4 Identify and compare discourses of childhood underpinning diverse early

childhood provision.

Part 4: Assessment

Assessment strategy: The assessment will be through a presentation and an

essay. These have been selected so that students have the opportunity to build on

their academic and transferable professional skills by writing at greater length, and

developing their ability to present well. In additional, it will give students the

opportunity to make links between policy and practice.

Teaching will include opportunities for formative assessment and student reflection.

In this way students can build their knowledge and reflect on their understandings to

achieve a comprehensive engagement with the learning outcomes of the module.

The module includes two summative assessments: Assessment 1 will be a group

presentation of 6 minutes per person, weighted at 25% and Assessment 2 is a 3000

word essay weighted at 75%. There will also be formative assessment opportunities

to scaffold learning and prepare for assessments, for example students will compare

and contrast curricula using frameworks during taught sessions.
