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Part 3: Teaching and learning methods

Teaching and learning methods: The student is given responsibility for a specialised area of a public production at Departmental Management level under the supervision of a subject specialist tutor. Each student will be part of at least one department depending on the development of their own interest and commitment to areas of production. This decision relates to the area of specialism they wish to pursue at level 3 and / or the area of employment they may wish to enter on gaining their award.

Module Learning outcomes: On successful completion of this module students will achieve the following learning outcomes.
