Part 2: Description

 This module focuses on evidence and principles that underpin the interventions and support for families and carers of a person with complex mental illness

This module will use a range of learning and teaching strategies to support student learning and will include:

- Group work
- Self-directed learning
- Digital learning delivered through Blackboard and other virtual learning platforms

Part 3: Assessment: Strategy and Details

The assessment strategy for this module is designed to allow a diverse range of students to be able to explore their own current and future practice focusing on an existing and or emerging model of care.

Formative assessment: Students will be given the opportunity to have feedback on an assignment plan to inform the final assessment

Summative assessment: The assignment is by way of a 2000 word review of the provision of family work. This will either be a reflective case study or review of collaborative working with families and carers (to be negotiated with the module leader).
