Part 3: Assessment

The assessment for this module will be a Critical Analysis of Practice that draws on examples of your practice learning around the key themes:

Professional judgement and the dynamics of power and authority in anti-oppressive practice

Working in partnership with service users and carers and other professions

Development of own critical reflection strategies for professional development.

Formative assessment is built into the module with the use of critical reflective models that you will apply in small group work to analyse practice examples using with peers and facilitator feedback and providing feedback to others. You will be encouraged to capture these reflections practising critical reflective writing in class.
