**Educational aims:** The module enables students to gain a critical understanding of the challenges and benefits of cross-cultural working. Completion of this module

requires students to both complete the specific assessment tasks set out below - supported through this process by the Module Leader and seminar tutors – and to satisfactorily meet the requirements set out in the module handbook for cross-cultural experience.

The module aims to provide students with the opportunity:

To combine the experience of cross-cultural working with academic reflection and critical analysis.

For continuing personal and professional development as relates to their ongoing employability.

**Outline syllabus:** This module provides students with the opportunity to work in an international team to complete a group project with students from other universities across the World. Working collaboratively on a significant international group project, students will develop their cross cultural understanding, make international network connections and develop valuable skills for future employment in the global marketplace. In the second semester, students will attend a range of international guest speaker masterclasses, addressing current issues and challenges global business practice and development.

## Part 3: Teaching and learning methods

**Teaching and learning methods:** Students will engage in collaborative group learning in the first 6 weeks of the semester as part of a Global Virtual Team of students based in Universities around the world, followed by regular business masterclass lectures and workshops in the second half of the semester.
