Part 2: Description

Overview: This is a work based learning module, students must be employed in a paid role, normally for a minimum of 32 weeks, and during that time are subject to the terms and conditions set by their employing Placement organisation. Any employment must be approved through university placement approval procedures. Co-requisites: Module to be taken during a period of paid employment with a minimum duration of 32 weeks.

Features: Module Entry requirements: students must take 210 credits, of which 90 must be at level 2 or above.

Educational Aims: See Learning Outcomes.

Outline Syllabus: There is no taught syllabus as such for this module, students are guided through the completion of the Placement Portfolio and appropriate resources are made available via pebblepad and Blackboard to support students in the completion of each task.

Teaching and Learning Methods: The module team and the university's central Placement Support team maintains regular contact with all students via UWE email, MS Teams or similar, and Blackboard.

This module is studied whilst working with an employer in a defined paid work role. This is therefore a fully work based and placement learning module and as such there is no formal teaching. The module primarily uses a distance learning approach to self-managed learning.

STUDENT AND ACADEMIC SERVICES

Placement tutors provide support with the completion of the module's assessment tasks and where relevant, supervision of any research activities. The placement tutor also aims to visit the student in their placement place of work. Where this is not possible, due to distance or other constraints, the student will be offered a virtual meeting via MS Teams or similar. If more convenient, the student may also be encouraged to visit their tutor at UWE.

Part 3: Assessment

An individual e-portfolio is maintained over the time that the student is on placement as a 'container' for academic outputs at regular intervals, and as evidence of professional work in progress, and to track and reflect on professional and personal development.

Portfolio submissions occur at scheduled intervals during the module, this allows for formative feedback from module tutors throughout the student's time on placement as well as end point summative assessment.
