- If this module is taken in conjunction with any other Independent Study module the portfolios should be distinct.
- The portfolio should be equivalent to 3000 words.

The student will follow a pre-determined course of work and assessment under the guidance of a member of academic staff. Appropriate guidance and formative feedback will be provided in line with the student's level of study and prior experience.
