In the process of this you will develop your ability to identify key information and ideas from a range of sources, structure your work and produce a sustained piece of work with reference to your sources. You will also further develop your ability to work independently, with the support of your tutor/s.

Teaching and learning methods

Scheduled teaching and learning -This will include seminars, skills workshops, online engagement and activities, and tutorials.

Independent learning – This module involves a significant amount of independent learning. This will include reading, directed tasks, working on personal skills and knowledge, preparation for and completion of assignments.

Part 3: Assessment
