## Part 2: Description

In this module, you will critically analyse a range of leadership qualities and theory using your own work and experiences. Unlike competing approaches to understanding leadership, which focus on organisations, this module has a personal focus. Progress through this module is primarily through self-directed learning, which permits a flexible exploration of leadership qualities guided by your needs. You will be able to extend your academic skills of analysing, synthesising and critically evaluating leadership, reflect on your own leadership practice, core leadership qualities, and develop a life-long learning ethos.

#### Part 3: Assessment

The assessment on this module is a critical reflection on a development portfolio of a series of direct and indirect leadership experiences.

- The written assignment will allow you to develop your reflection skills and personal leadership qualities in relation to complex organisational life. This will allow you to engage with life-long learning.
- The module will be supported though supervision only and this will develop your abilities to be selfdirected in your learning.
